In the heart of Boston's Back Bay situated next to Boyd/Smith's flagship property, Church Park, sits the Carillon, a nine-story, 32-unit residential condominium building with commercial space at the pedestrian level. Named for the harmonious bells that chime at the magnificent Christian Science Church across the street, the Carillon was designed by F. William Smith and Insight Partners to architecturally complement Church Park and the surrounding structures.

Completed in 2002, the Carillon offers high-end custom finishes including maple kitchen cabinetry, granite counter tops, magnificent skyline-views on the common roof top terrace, deeded underground parking, and hardwood flooring. Designed with just four units per floor, the layout allows for a uniquely spacious entrance foyer in each residence.

The Carillon is conveniently located near exclusive shops, cultural venues (including Symphony Hall), Fenway Park, phenomenal restaurants, world-class gardens and parks, all mere steps away. Life at the Carillon is decidedly urban and incredibly convenient.
